# Alumni Advisory Council







At the core of the University's plan is the launching of the Alumni Advisory Council (A.A.C); a special body that will be working directly with the President and the Council of Deans on strategic assignments as well as represent the University in special events and social functions. The A.A.C is made up of 36 members distributed in different countries.

The goal of this council is to build an active global alumni network to support the achievement of the University's Primary Goals by providing leadership and support to a University-wide Alumni Relations Program that demonstrates the mutual value of engagement for Alumni, the University of Balamand and the wider community. Three committees will be formed: Alumni Ambassadors, Professional Development Committee, and Public Relations Committee.

The 18 members who were able to attend met for the first time with President Salem and the Council of Deans on 28 March 2018. This session was important in terms of showcasing the progress of the University as well as the challenges that await them. The day was concluded with photo opportunities and a luncheon at Salem House.

## Akkar Fundraiser

On April 21, 2018, the First Issam M. Fares Faculty of Technology Annual Dinner, entitled "Supporting Access to Education in Akkar", was held in Greenland restaurant, Edbel, Akkar. The event was attended by His Eminence, the Most Reverend Metropolitan Basilios (Mansour), Beirut Governor Mr. Ziad Chbib, Mrs. Lilian Sajii Attieh, representing former Deputy Prime Minister Issam Fares, President of the union of the municipalities of al-Jouma Mr. Fadi Barbar, heads of municipalities and mayors, in addition to a large number of influential community figures who share the University's commitment in providing access to quality higher education to the young men and women of Akkar, as well as professors, administrators and students of the university.

### **Dubai Fundraiser**

# **UOBMC**

The University of Balamand Medical Center (UOBMC) is under construction on the periphery of the main campus in the North. It will serve as an extension to the Faculty of Medicine and Medical Sciences, its mission being to offer medical education and research opportunities to students, and provide effective and affordable medical care for all patients. A land area of 140,000 square meters has been reserved for the complex and its future expansion.

The Center will include a 37,000 square-meter general hospital. It has been designed according to the standards of the American Facility Guidelines Institute, and received accreditation from Joint Commission International (JCI) and Safe Health Design (SHD). It will accommodate one hundred ninety beds and thirty outpatient clinics, offering a full range of inpatient and outpatient healthcare services. Completion is expected by May 2020.
