

# REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

## Spring 2024

### I- Pre-Registration: December 04 to 08, 2023.

- 1- Log in to Student Information System (SIS) to retrieve your payment slip.
- 2- Before registration, kindly pay a **non-refundable Payment On Account** in the amount of 7,500,000 L.P and 600 US dollars in cash at the university to be deducted from the tuition fees if registered.
- 3- Check the posted course offering to decide which courses you need to register.
- 4- Register online according to the following schedule:

- 5- Log in and get your courses registered; in case you face any problem, kindly ask your advisor for assistance or call the Office of the Registrar at extensions 1213, 1670, or 1245 to solve your problem.
- 6- Print your course schedule and make sure that all the information is correct ( ID, name, semester, major, courses, and sections). **You are fully responsible for all data listed on your printout.**
- 7- **Log out and make sure you click the X button on the top right-hand corner.**
- 8- Log in to Student Information System (SIS) to print your payment slip, 72 hours following your pre-registration.

### II- Final Registration:

Pay at the Bank before January 04, 2024 as a deadline; **otherwise, your pre-registration will be cancelled.**

### III- Late Registration:

From January 15 to January 19, 2024.  
A fee of 1,000,000 L.P. will be charged.



### IV- Withdrawals

If, for justifiable reasons, a student decided to withdraw after registration, fees are refunded according to the following policy:

Before the official beginning of semester	75% of full tuition fees
During the first week of semester	50% of full tuition fees
During the second week of semester	25% of full tuition fees
After the second week of semester	0% (The student will receive a grade of " W " on all courses and will be 100% financially responsible.)
